**Girl Scouts Heart of the Hudson, Inc.
2008-2009 Product Sales Program
Participation of the Juliette Girl Scout**

Introduction:

The following guidelines will address the participation of the Juliette Girl Scout in the GSHH's Product Sales Program, including the Fall Product Sale 2008 and Cookies in spring 2009. These guidelines will be used for GSHH's fiscal year 2009 and refined thereafter pending GSUSA's Safety-Wise revisions.

Through these guidelines, we hope to offer the Juliette Girl Scout an opportunity to participate in the Product Sales Program and enjoy the benefits of the credits she has earned.

Guidelines:

As per Girl Scouts Safety Wise Standard 30, the income from products sales cannot become the property of an individual girl member. As a result, Council will hold funds earned by a Juliette through her participation in the Products Sales Program, in a restricted Juliette account. By way of this account, the Juliette can request the use of her funds on Girl Scouts Heart of the Hudson activities of her choice. These funds held in the name of the Juliette will expire 1 year from the last date of the sale, i.e., for the 2008 Fall Product Sale-11/7/09, for Cookies 2009 – 5/31/10. A Juliette may request an extension to this expiration date, if she can demonstrate her long-term plans for the use of the Product Sales funds. The deadline for requesting that extension is 30 days prior to the expiration date. The extension should be requested by the Juliette through her council Product Sales Manager. A list of Product Sales Managers is held on the GSHH's website (www.girlscoutshh.org).

For example, a Juliette may use her Product Sales funds for GSHH program activities; council summer camp; any items offered for sale in the council shop or online and any costs associated with her achievement of the Bronze, Silver or Gold awards. The funds can only be applied to activities that are approved Girl Scout program activities, council or national sponsored program events.

In order to track a Juliette's funds accurately, all Juliette Girl Scouts must have their information input into a Troop number which will be the designated county (*1- Dutchess, 2-Orange, 3-Putnam, 4-Rockland, 5-Sullivan, 6-Ulster, 7-Weschester*) followed by the community number and then a "0", i.e., Community 503 in Sullivan county would be 55030. This is a special troop dedicated to the needs of a Juliette Girl Scout in your community.

In addition to the funds a Juliette may earn, she is also eligible to earn any incentives offered to all girls in exchange for participation in GSHH Product Sales. These incentives will be delivered directly to the Product Sales Manager of the community she belongs to.

Note: A Juliette's funds are available only to the registered GSHH Juliette Girl Scout who earned them. They are not transferrable.
